Each student had the opportunity to choose how they would like to become involved in the musical. Please ask your student which task they have chosen. The student's part is also highlighted below. Here are the expectations for each part.

Solo/Small Group: Students are practicing their portion of the song. The part should be memorized.

Speaking Part: Students are practicing their lines at home. Their part should be memorized.

Props: Students are expected to create a piece of a forest, such as a tree, flowers, an animal etc. If needed, materials can be picked up from Miss Lauderdale.

For costuming, please keep in mind students may choose to dress up in a few different choices. If students are assigned a specific speaking part, please see below list for some ideas. Other students may choose between a forest animal, a robber, or storyteller clothing. The students will need to be able to move around in their costumes, so please do not let the costume get in the way of the performance. The costume does not need to be store bought and can be created from items the student already owns. Here are a few ideas.

Wilhelm and Jake Grimm: Blazers, Corduroy Pants, Glasses, Bow Ties

Donkey: Dark Shirt, Dark Pants, Donkey Ears

Dog: Dark Shirt, Dark Pants, Dog Ears

Cat: Orange/Brown Shirt, Cat Ears, Tail

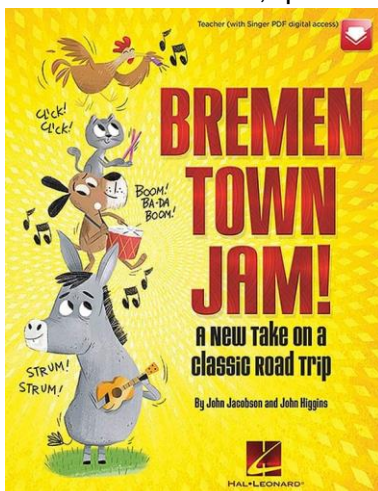
Rooster: White Shirt, Red Hat, Feather Boa

Robbers: White and Black Striped Shirts, Black Beanies, Eye Masks
